State Energy Program (SEP)

Total Award: \$42.1 million

Based on existing state program
Must realize 10 MMBTU energy savings/ \$1000
Cannot be used for new construction
Consult with State Historic Preservation Office

Energy Efficiency & Conservation Block Grant (EECBG)

Total Award: \$9.5 million

60% to cities/counties
\$1.7 million to Solar Highway
Consult with State Historic Preservation Office
Not tied to existing programs

State Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program (SEEARP)

Total Award: \$3.6 million

Used for heating system upgrades in low-income households
Partnering with Low Income Home Energy Assistance program

July 9 – August 10, 2009

ODOE receives formal applications from state & local governments for initial \$21 million in SEP funds.

August 21, 2009

USDOE provides initial \$363,000 for Appliance Rebate Program.

September 18, 2009

USDOE issues final installment of \$21 million for SEP.

September 21, 2009

22 Schools projects announced (SEP). \$531,042 awarded.

September 29, 2009

USDOE Awards \$9.5 million for Block Grant. All money to be disbursed within 180 days.

October 2, 2009

21 Eastern Oregon projects announced. \$1.3 million in SEP funds awarded.

October 15, 2009

Appliance Rebate Program application submitted to USDOE.

October 20, 2009

97 Western Oregon projects announced. \$7.1 million in SEP funds awarded.

November 1 – December 15, 2009

Formal application period for Block Grant.

December 1, 2009

Expected program start date for Appliance Rebate Program.
